ICYMI: The visiting Hillcats erased a one run deficit in their final at-bat with a seven run and seven hit ninth while defeating the Mudcats 8-2 at Five County Stadium on Thursday night. Lynchburg's Claudio Bautista was 2-for-4 with two runs and the go-ahead RBI double in the comeback victory. The loss dropped Carolina to six games back of first place Winston-Salem in the second half playoff race. Carolina's elimination number is down to four with 10 games left.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Last night's 8-2 loss marked the first time this season that Carolina had lost a lead in the ninth inning at Five County Stadium... Lynchburg's seven runs in the ninth last night were the most allowed in the ninth inning this season by Mudcats pitchers... Bradley Roney's blown save last night was his first with Carolina and the eighth for the Mudcats this year.

ON TO THE NEXT ONE: Carolina's final homestand of the season continues tonight with game two of a four game series with the visiting Lynchburg Hillcats. The Mudcats lost last night's series opener and look to even the series with RHP Brandon Barker getting the game two start tonight in Zebulon. Barker enters tonight's outing at 8-4 with a 3.00 ERA over 16 starts this season with the Mudcats. Barker is 11-9 and has posted a 3.32 ERA over 25 starts between Low-A, High-A and Triple-A this season. He currently leads the Braves farm system in strikeouts (102) and wins (11).

ELIMINATION NUMBER: The Mudcats enter tonight's game 6.0 games back of the first place Winston-Salem Dash in the 2nd half standings and have an elimination number of four (4). Both teams have 10 games remaining this season, but the Dash will play two fewer second half games having had two cancellations this half. Winston-Salem's final stretch of games include three at home vs. Frederick, three in Wilmington and four more on the road vs. the Keys.

SO HOT: Dustin Peterson is 10-for-20 (.500/.476/.650, 2r, 3 2b, 6rbi) over his last five games and 18-for-46 (.391/.408/.587) over his last 11. He currently leads the league in average (.391) and RBI (12) since August 16.

TOP THIRD: Keith Curcio, Connor Lien and Dustin Peterson were a combined 8-for-14 (4r and 5 RBI) while batting first, second and third respectively in Tuesday's 7-4 win versus Wilmington. The season high for combined hits in a game for the top three Mudcats' batters is 10 and was set on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (Sean Godfrey 3-for-5, 3r, Eric Garcia 4-for-4, 2r, 2rbi, Peterson 3-for-5, 1r, 1rbi). The Mudcats top third also had back-to-back nine hits in games on 6/9 and 6/10 (6/9: Godfrey, Curcio, Peterson 9-for-15, 6r and 6/10: Godfrey, Curcio, Peterson 9-for-15, 1r).

#WINNING: The Mudcats are currently 4th in most wins in the league at 66-63 overall this season. Those 66 wins are the club's most during its Carolina League era. They were 62-74 in 2014, 57-83 in 2013 and 63-77 in 2012.

ALL THAT POWER: Jacob Schrader is currently 2nd in the league in isolated power (.199 ISO), 3rd in home runs (13), 3rd in slugging (.462) and 3rd in extra-base hits (44). Schrader is also currently 2nd in the league in extra-base hits (31) since 6/1... Carlos Franco is batting .263/.363/.421 with the 3rd most extra-base hits (30) in the CL since 6/1.

WHERE THEY RANK: Connor Lien is 3rd in the league in batting average (.286), tied for 2nd in stolen bases (32) and tied for 2nd in most strikeouts (119)... Carlos Franco is tied for the 3rd most games played in the league (124) and 5th in most base on balls (56)... Seth Webster is 2nd in the league in earned run average (2.75), is 2nd in WHIP (1.07), 1st in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.55) and 2nd in fewest baserunners (9.81)... Blair Walters is 4th in the league in ERA (2.93) and 3rd in average against (.244).

FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH:

- 2015 Mudcats reliever Matt Marksberry made his MLB debut on 7/31 in PHI (1.2ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 0so, 2ir-2irs).
- The Mudcats have the league's second best record when scoring first this season (48-21, .696)
- The Mudcats are 32-28 and are batting .239 with an average of 3.78 runs/game and a 3.25 ERA in the Second Half.
- The Mudcats are 47-39 since snapping their 12 game losing streak on May 29 (.248 avg, 4.03 runs/game, 3.27 ERA).
- Carolina's 10 remaining games include three (3) vs. Frederick and seven (7) vs. Lynchburg.
- The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 while a member of the Southern League (Double-A, Florida Marlins).
- Seth Webster leads all of Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio (12.14) among qualified pitchers.
- Connor Lien leads the league in most outfield assists (18) and double plays (6).

MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

BRICENO: Was 2-for-4 on 6/28 and brought his avg. up to .200 or above (.203) for the first time since 4/15 (.200). CURCIO: Hit .542/.656/.792 (6r, 3 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) between 6/8 and 6/14 and was named Player of the Week. CAMARGO: First home run of the season was a 2-run shot to right on 8/16 in Frederick. FRANCO: Led the Carolina League with 14 extra base hits in June (14 xbh, 8 2b, 2 3b, 4hr). GIARDINA: Had back-to-back multi hit games on 5/30 (2-for-4, R) and 5/31 (2-for-4, RBI) versus Wilmington. HARPER: Was 1-for-2 w/2 RBI on 7/2 vs. WS. Also made bare hand catch that was SportsCenter's Top 10 No. 1 play. **KRIETEMEIER:** Hit safely in 5 straight games between 7/24-8/15 and had go-ahead 2-run 2B in 10th in Wilmington. LIEN: Hit .375/.429/.667 from 7/6-7/12 (9-for-24, 3r, 2hr, 6rbi, 5sb, 1.095 OPS) and was named Player of the Week. MENESES: Snapped a season high 12 game hitting streak after going 0-for-1 as a PH on 8/22 in Winston-Salem. **ODOM:** Hit first professional grand slam on 6/9 vs. Potomac. The GS gave Carolina a 13-10 lead in the 8th. PETERSON: Went 4-for-4 for the second time in a game this season on 8/24 vs. Wilmington at FCS. SCHRADER: Leads the Mudcats and Braves farm system with 13 home runs this season.

TL;DR:

- Leads the Braves farm system in strikeouts (102) and wins (11) this season.
- Is tied for 1st in the league in wins (8) since June 1st. Is also 5th in earned run average (2.94) and 6th in WHIP (1.16) since June 1.
- Was named the Mudcats pitcher of the month for June by the Atlanta Braves after going 2-1 with a 2.94 ERA over six starts.
- Originally transferred to Carolina from Rome on 5/14.
- Allowed two runs on six hits in Mudcats debut on 5/16 vs. Myrtle Beach.
- Returned to Rome for two starts between 5/22 and 5/27 (2gs, 12.0ip, 10h, 5r, 2er, 2bb, 11so).
- Allowed season high six earned runs on eight hits in final start with Rome before first transfer to Carolina.
- Made spot start for Triple-A Gwinnett on 7/5 vs. Charlotte (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). Left with two men on (both later scored) in the fifth.
- Struck out career high nine (9) on 7/17 vs. Winston-Salem at Five County Stadium (5ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 2hr, 1bb, 9so)
- 2014: Earned a win in four straight appearances between 7/13 and 7/31 with Rome.
- Was 4-1 with a 4.61 ERA over six games and one start in July 2014 with Rome.
- Was 5-0 with a 3.00 ERA over seven games in relief (18ip, 19h, 7r, 6er, 4bb, 21so) in 2014 with Rome.
- Was 0-2 with a 4.96 ERA over five starts in 2014 (16.1ip, 20h, 9r, 9er, 1hr, 8bb, 11so)
- Left-handed batters hit .301 (18-for-58) against Barker in 2014.
- Mercer teammate Chesny Young was drafted by the Cubs in the 14th round of the 2014 draft and currently plays for Myrtle Beach.

LAST START: Brandon Barker last started for Carolina on 8/23 in Winston-Salem and suffered a loss despite allowing just two runs over six plus innings pitched. He worked into the seventh and struck out six in what was his first loss since 7/27.

2015: Barker was named the Mudcats pitcher of the month for June by the Atlanta Braves after going 2-1 with a 2.94 ERA over six starts. He finished June with 16 strikeouts and eight walks over 33.2 innings pitched and held opponents to a .248 batting average.

He began July with Triple-A Gwinnett for a spot start on 7/5 and was eventually reassigned back to Carolina on 7/7. Barker pitched into the fifth during his outing with the Braves against Charlotte at Coolray Field in Gwinnett. He left the game with two runners on base and with the game tied 2-2. Reliever Aaron Kurcz took over out of the pen and allowed both inherited runners to score. Barker ended up suffering the loss and finished with seven strikeouts, three walks, and four runs allowed on four hits over four and 1/3 innings pitched.

Barker was transferred to Carolina on 5/14 and made one start with the Mudcats before being assigned back to Class A Rome. He allowed two earned runs on six hits over 4.1 innings against Myrtle Beach in his Mudcats debut on 5/16 at Five County Stadium... Barker was 2-3 with a 4.30 ERA over six games and six starts with Class A Rome before his first assignment to Carolina on 5/14. Over those six starts, Barker allowed 14 earned runs (16 total) over 29.1 innings pitched. He also struck out 24, walked 11 and allowed two home runs. Barker was 0-3 with a 9.49 ERA over three starts at home and 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA in three starts on the road before the original transfer. He allowed just one earned run on 12 hits and struck out 16 over 17.0 innings away from Rome before the first transfer on 5/14. He struck out seven and allowed just four hits over seven scoreless innings on 4/28 in Lexington and earned his first of two consecutive wins. Barker allowed a season worst six earned run and eight hits over 5.1 innings during his final start with Rome before the original move to Carolina.

BARKER: Made spot start for Triple-A Gwinnett on 7/5 vs. Charlotte (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). Left with two men on (both later scored) in the fifth. BROSIUS: Placed on the disabled list on 5/14. Last pitched on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (6.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 1bb, 4so).

BYWATER: Struck out seven over seven scoreless frames while earning his first win on 8/20 vs. Salem at Five County Stadium.

FURNEY: Struck out a season high seven batters over seven innings on 5/22 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 8h, 3r, 2er, 2bb, 7so).

GIL: Tossed a seven inning one-hit shutout (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 6so) while earning his second straight victory since returning from Rome on 8/24 vs Wilmington. JANAS: Placed on disabled list on 5/8. Led the league in ERA (0.56), WHIP (0.53) and lowest average against (.140) before going on DL.

PARSONS: Earned a victory in his first start with Carolina on 7/21 vs. Wilmington (5ip, 8h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 0so).

POVSE: Held the Red Sox to a run and four hits over six quality innings and earned first win on 7/9 in Salem.

SIMS: Struck out a season high eight batters over six full innings on 7/16 vs. Winston-Salem. Earned the win after allowing just one run on five hits.

THURMAN: Allowed a leadoff double, but then retired 21 straight over seven scoreless and one-hit innings on 8/2 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 7so). **WALTERS:** Pitched through the seventh for the first time on 7/1 and earned his third win of the season as a starter.

WASZAK: Took a no-hitter into the seventh on 7/2 vs. Winston-Salem at Five County Stadium (W, 6.2ip, 1h, 1r, 0er, 2bb, 6so).

WEBSTER: Led Carolina League in earned run average from 8/16 through 8/21 (2.52 ERA).

WHALEN: Was acquired by the Braves in a four player trade with the Mets on July 24. Acquired along with RHP John Gant for Kelly Johnson and Juan Uribe.

NEAR PERFECTION: RHP Steve Janas took a perfect game into the seventh inning of game one of a doubleheader against the Lynchburg Hillcats on 5/6. #4 - Luis Salazar, Manager

Luis Salazar is entering his fifth season with the Atlanta Braves and his first as the manager of the Carolina Mudcats. The 2015 season marks Salazar's 13th year as a minor league manager. Salazar guided Atlanta's previous Class A Advanced club, the Lynchburg Hillcats, to the playoffs in three of the last four years. His 2012 Hillcats club finished 72-68 and won the Carolina League title versus Winston Salem. Salazar first joined the Braves organization in 2011 after spending three years as the hitting coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers Double A affiliate. He has over 15 years of coaching experience and in his career has compiled a 567-623 career record. Salazar has also managed the Vero Beach Dodgers (Class A, 2006), the Gulf Coast League Dodgers (Rookie, 2002-2005) and the Beloit Snappers (Class A, 1996-1997). Additionally, Salazar has been the hitting coach for Triple A Louisville (1998-1999) and Triple A Indianapolis (2000). Salazar played in 13

major league seasons and for four different teams. He played for the San Diego Padres (1980-1984, 1987, 1989), the Chicago White Sox (1985-1986), the Detroit Tigers (1988) and the Chicago Cubs (1989-1992). Salazar hit .261 with 1,070 hits over his 13 year MLB playing career.

#43 - Derrick Lewis, Pitching Coach

The 2015 season marks the third for Derrick Lewis as the pitching coach of Atlanta's Class A Advanced affiliate and his 13th overall in the Braves system. Lewis has been the pitching coach of the Lynchburg Hillcats (2011-2014), Rome Braves (2008-2010) Danville Braves (2004-2007) and the Gulf Coast League Braves (2004-2007). Lewis' Danville Braves staff led the Appalachian League in earned run average (3.05), innings (604.2) and saves (26). They were also second in the league in strikeouts with 582. Lewis began his playing career with the Braves in 1997 when they selected him in the 20th round of the 1997 draft. His playing career as a pitcher in the Atlanta system lasted from 1997 through 2003. He was the Braves organizational pitcher of the year in 1999 after finishing second in the Carolina League in ERA while pitching for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. In his career, Lewis was 31-37 with a 4.04 ERA over 161 MiLB games.

#35 - Carlos Mendez, Hitting Coach

Carlos Mendez enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Carolina Mudcats, his second with the Braves Class A Advanced club and his ninth season overall in the Braves organization. Mendez originally began last season with rookie level Danville, but was later assigned to Lynchburg in mid-April. Mendez joined the Braves organization in 2008 as the hitting instructor for Danville and remained with the rookie level Braves through 2010. He then took over as the hitting coach in Rome from 2011 to 2012. In 2013, Mendez served as the hitting coach of the Gulf Coast League Braves before returning to Danville in 2014. Mendez's playing career lasted from 1991 through 2007. Over those 16 seasons, Mendez would play for five different organizations including Kansas City, Detroit, Oakland, Baltimore and Atlanta. He was a career .296 hitter in the minors and a perennial all-star. Mendez reached the big leagues in 2003 with the Baltimore Orioles. He played in 26 games for the O's over four months and hit .222 with 10 hits and two doubles. He was originally signed by Kansas City as a non-drafted free agent in 1991.
