**ICYMI:** Keith Curcio was 3-for-4 with a run and two batted in, Dustin Peterson drove in two with two hits and Bradley Roney left the bases loaded while earning his fifth save as the Mudcats held off the Keys with an 8-5 win at Nymeo Field at Harry Grove Stadium on Tuesday night.

**ABOUT THE LAST ONE:** The first, second and third hitters (**Connor Lien, Keith Curcio, Dustin Peterson**) in last night's game each drove in two runs apiece. It was first time that the one, two and three hitters in the lineup each collected at least one RBI since July 31. It also matched the season high for runs driven in by the first third of the lineup this season (July 9 at Salem, 6 RBI).

**ON TO THE NEXT ONE:** The Mudcats continue their final road trip of the season tonight with two of three against the Keys at Nymeo Stadium in Frederick. The Mudcats lead the current series 1-0 having won the opener last night 8-5.

**Seth Webster** gets the game two nod for the Mudcats and enters tonight's start at 8-7 with a 2.75 ERA this season. Webster is currently 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in earned run average and leads Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio at 12.14.

**TRENDING:** Carlos Franco has reached safely via base on balls in five straight games and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in most walks in August (20)... Dustin Peterson is batting .350 (14-for-40, 4r, 8rbi) over his last 10 games... Justin Jackson has two saves and a 0.00 ERA over his last six games and 9.0 innings pitched... Andy Otero has not allowed an inherited runner to score since 7/4 (10ir-0irs since 7/4).

**THE TRIP TO TRIPS:** Starting pitcher **Brandon Barker** was transferred to Triple-A Gwinnett by the Braves today. The promotion is his second this year to Triple-A. Barker was previously sent to Gwinnett for a spot start on 7/7 (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). The Braves also promoted Carolina League Designated Hitter of the year **Jacob Schrader** to Triple-A Gwinnett on 9/1. Reliever **Matt Marksberry** was the first Mudcats player to make the jump to the Gwinnett Braves. He was promoted to Gwinnett on 8/29 and appeared in 16 games (0-2, 5.63 ERA, 16.0ip, 10bb, 13so) before receiving a big league promotion on 7/31.

**YEAR-END ALL-STARS:** The Carolina League recognized **Johan Camargo, Connor Lien** and **Jacob Schrader** as year-end All-Stars on 8/29. Camargo was recognized as the league's top shortstop, Lien was listed as one of four All-Star outfielders and Schrader earned designated hitter of the year honors.

**FIRST IMPRESSION:** Connor Lien has led off a game 15 times in the second half and the Mudcats are 11-4 with him as their leadoff man in the lineup. Lien is batting .281/.364/.473 (16-for-57, 16r, 3 2b, 1 3b, 2hr, 9rbi, 5bb, 21so) as the leadoff man in the second half. Keith Curcio is batting .214/.264/.321 (42-for-196, 21r, 5 2b, 5 3b, 2hr, 15rbi, 13bb, 37so) as Carolina's primary leadoff man in the second half. The Mudcats are 23-25 with Curcio as their leadoff batter in the second half. Curcio is also batting .330/.413/.451 overall this season when batting second in the lineup.

**#WINNING:** The Mudcats are currently 4<sup>th</sup> in most wins in the league at 68-65 overall this season. Those 68 wins are the club's most during its Carolina League era. They were 62-74 in 2014, 57-83 in 2013 and 63-77 in 2012.

**WHERE THEY RANK:** Connor Lien is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in batting average (.283), tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> in stolen bases (32) and leads the league in most strikeouts (125)... Carlos Franco is tied for the 2<sup>nd</sup> most games played in the league (128) and tied for 4<sup>th</sup> in most base on balls (60). Franco is also 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in extra-base (30) hits since June 1... Seth Webster is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in earned run average (2.75), is 2<sup>nd</sup> in WHIP (1.07), 1<sup>st</sup> in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.55) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in fewest baserunners (9.81)... Blair Walters is 5<sup>th</sup> in the league in ERA (3.00) and 3<sup>rd</sup> in avg. against (.244).

### FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH:

- 2015 Mudcats reliever **Matt Marksberry** made his MLB debut on 7/31 in PHI (1.2ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 0so, 2ir-2irs).
- The Mudcats are 34-30 and are batting .241 with an average of 3.78 runs/game and a 3.30 ERA in the Second Half.
- The Mudcats are 49-41 since snapping their 12 game losing streak on May 29 (.248 avg, 4.02 runs/game, 3.30 ERA).
- The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 while a member of the Southern League (Double-A, Florida Marlins).
- **Seth Webster** leads Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio (12.14) among qualified pitchers.
- **Connor Lien** leads the league in most outfield assists (19) and double plays (6).

### MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

**BRICENO:** Was 2-for-4 on 6/28 and brought his avg. up to .200 or above (.203) for the first time since 4/15 (.200).

**CURCIO:** Hit .542/.656/.792 (6r, 3 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) between 6/8 and 6/14 and was named Player of the Week.

**CAMARGO:** First home run of the season was a 2-run shot to right on 8/16 in Frederick.

**FRANCO:** Led the Carolina League with 14 extra base hits in June (14 xbh, 8 2b, 2 3b, 4hr).

**GEBHARDT:** Was signed as a minor league free agent by the Braves on 8/20. Began year in Arizona system.

**GIARDINA:** Had back-to-back multi hit games on 5/30 (2-for-4, R) and 5/31 (2-for-4, RBI) versus Wilmington.

**HARPER:** Was 1-for-2 w/2 RBI on 7/2 vs. WS. Also made bare hand catch that was SportsCenter's Top 10 No. 1 play.

**KRIETEMEIER:** Hit safely in 5 straight games between 7/24-8/15 and had go-ahead 2-run 2B in 10<sup>th</sup> in Wilmington.

**LIEN:** Hit .375/.429/.667 from 7/6-7/12 (9-for-24, 3r, 2hr, 6rbi, 5sb, 1.095 OPS) and was named Player of the Week.

**MENESES:** Snapped a season high 12 game hitting streak after going 0-for-1 as a PH on 8/22 in Winston-Salem.

**ODOM:** Hit first professional grand slam on 6/9 vs. Potomac. The GS gave Carolina a 13-10 lead in the 8<sup>th</sup>.

**PETERSON:** Went 4-for-4 for the second time in a game this season on 8/24 vs. Wilmington at FCS.

**TL;DR:**

- Currently 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Carolina League in earned run average (2.75), 2<sup>nd</sup> in WHIP (1.07) and 1<sup>st</sup> in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.55).
- Owns Minor League Baseball's best K/BB ratio (12.14) among qualified pitchers.
- Leads the Carolina League in most innings pitched since making his debut on May 23 (117.2 innings).
- Webster's 1.5 BB% and 12.14 K/BB ratio is the best in the Carolina League this season.
- Pitched 45.1 consecutive innings without issuing a walk between starts on 6/11 and 7/25.
- Led Mudcats to losing streak (12 straight) snapping victory on 5/29 against Myrtle Beach (W, 7.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 2bb, 6so)
- Became first Mudcats pitcher to pitch through the eighth on 7/3 vs. Winston-Salem (8.0ip, 7h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 5so).
- Was 14-6 with a 2.88 ERA over 31 games and 200.0 innings with the Schaumburg Boomers between 2013 and 2015.
- Was 3-0 with a 0.78 ERA over three post-season starts for the Frontier League champion Schaumburg Boomers in 2014 (23ip, 5h, 20so).
- Tossed a CG shutout with 13 strikeouts and just two hits allowed in a wild card playoff game against Lake Erie last season.
- Clinched the Boomers' second straight Frontier League title with a seven inning effort against River City last season (7.0ip, 1r).
- Before signing with Atlanta, Webster was the Schaumburg franchise career leader in starts, innings, complete games, wins and strikeouts.
- Finished the 2014 season sixth in the Frontier League in innings pitched with 118.0.
- Was named the American Southwest Conference East Division Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 1.77 ERA (91.2ip, 65so) with DIII Louisiana College.
- Led the American Southwest Conference in wins (10), complete games (11) and shutouts (4) while with the Louisiana College Wildcats.

**LAST START:** Webster last pitched on 8/27 vs. Lynchburg and allowed just one run over seven innings pitched in his final home start of the season. He lost a 1-0 lead in the seventh, but the Mudcats later took the lead in the same frame. Carolina later lost the game 8-2 after allowing seven runs in the ninth. Webster finished the start with seven strikeouts and eight hits allowed.

**2015: 5/29:** Webster shutout the visiting Pelicans over seven full innings while leading the Mudcats to a 12 game losing streak snapping 2-0 victory at Five County Stadium on May 29. He struck out six, walked two and held Myrtle Beach to four hits over seven scoreless while earning his first victory of the season... **7/3:** Allowed just two runs over a season high eight innings pitched and struck out five. Webster allowed a run in the second and one in the sixth and gave up seven hits in the loss. **7/8:** Struck out a season high eight batters while allowing just two runs over six and 2/3 innings pitched. **7/25:** Kept the Pelicans without a run over seven full innings pitched while throwing 91 pitches with 58 for strikes. He walked one, struck out one and scattered four hits in the victory. **7/30:** Finished with just two runs allowed and seven strikeouts over six and 2/3 innings pitched while earning his second straight victory. **8/5:** Won his third straight start after allowing just one run over seven innings pitched against Winston-Salem. Scattered five hits, struck out seven and picked up his 10<sup>th</sup> quality start of the year. **8/16:** Allowed just one unearned run over seven innings pitched while picking up a win in Frederick against the Keys. He struck out eight, did not issue a walk and gave up six hits while lowering his then league best earned run average to 2.52 ERA on the season.

Webster was signed by the Braves a non-drafted free agent earlier this year from the Frontier League's Schaumburg Boomers. He made his Atlanta organizational debut with the Rome Braves on 5/18 against Charleston and allowed six earned runs on seven hits over five innings pitched. He walked two and struck out seven in his affiliated ball debut, and suffered the loss in a 6-2 loss to the RiverDogs. Webster was 14-6 with a 2.88 ERA over three seasons (31g, 200.0ip, 185h, 77r, 64er, 38bb, 145so) with the Boomers before signing with the Braves.

**#4 - Luis Salazar, Manager**

Luis Salazar is entering his fifth season with the Atlanta Braves and his first as the manager of the Carolina Mudcats. The 2015 season marks Salazar's 13th year as a minor league manager. Salazar guided Atlanta's previous Class A Advanced club, the Lynchburg Hillcats, to the playoffs in three of the last four years. His 2012 Hillcats club finished 72-68 and won the Carolina League title versus Winston Salem. Salazar first joined the Braves organization in 2011 after spending three years as the hitting coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers Double A affiliate. He has over 15 years of coaching experience and in his career has compiled a 567-623 career record. Salazar has also managed the Vero Beach Dodgers (Class A, 2006), the Gulf Coast League Dodgers (Rookie, 2002-2005) and the Beloit Snappers (Class A, 1996-1997). Additionally, Salazar has been the hitting coach for Triple A Louisville (1998-1999) and Triple A Indianapolis (2000). Salazar played in 13 major league seasons and for four different teams. He played for the San Diego Padres (1980-1984, 1987, 1989), the Chicago White Sox (1985-1986), the Detroit Tigers (1988) and the Chicago Cubs (1989-1992). Salazar hit .261 with 1,070 hits over his 13 year MLB playing career.

**#43 - Derrick Lewis, Pitching Coach**

The 2015 season marks the third for Derrick Lewis as the pitching coach of Atlanta's Class A Advanced affiliate and his 13th overall in the Braves system. Lewis has been the pitching coach of the Lynchburg Hillcats (2011-2014), Rome Braves (2008-2010) Danville Braves (2004-2007) and the Gulf Coast League Braves (2004-2007). Lewis' Danville Braves staff led the Appalachian League in earned run average (3.05), innings (604.2) and saves (26). They were also second in the league in strikeouts with 582. Lewis began his playing career with the Braves in 1997 when they selected him in the 20th round of the 1997 draft. His playing career as a pitcher in the Atlanta system lasted from 1997 through 2003. He was the Braves organizational pitcher of the year in 1999 after finishing second in the Carolina League in ERA while pitching for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. In his career, Lewis was 31-37 with a 4.04 ERA over 161 MiLB games.

**#35 - Carlos Mendez, Hitting Coach**

Carlos Mendez enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Carolina Mudcats, his second with the Braves Class A Advanced club and his ninth season overall in the Braves organization. Mendez originally began last season with rookie level Danville, but was later assigned to Lynchburg in mid-April. Mendez joined the Braves organization in 2008 as the hitting instructor for Danville and remained with the rookie level Braves through 2010. He then took over as the hitting coach in Rome from 2011 to 2012. In 2013, Mendez served as the hitting coach of the Gulf Coast League Braves before returning to Danville in 2014. Mendez's playing career lasted from 1991 through 2007. Over those 16 seasons, Mendez would play for five different organizations including Kansas City, Detroit, Oakland, Baltimore and Atlanta. He was a career .296 hitter in the minors and a perennial all-star. Mendez reached the big leagues in 2003 with the Baltimore Orioles. He played in 26 games for the O's over four months and hit .222 with 10 hits and two doubles. He was originally signed by Kansas City as a non-drafted free agent in 1991.
