**ICYMI:** **Yean Carlos Gil** worked through six and 1/3 scoreless and **Justin Jackson** pitched the final two and 2/3 without allowing a run while combining to shutout the Hillcats 1-0 on Friday night at Calvin Falwell Field in Lynchburg. Gil (W, 4-10, 5.16) struck out seven, scattered five hits and walked only two while earning his third win since returning from Class A Rome on August 15. He pitched into the seventh, but left after allowing two hits in the inning. Jackson (S, 5) followed out of the bullpen and managed to leave both inherited runners on base while holding the 1-0 lead.

**ABOUT THE LAST ONE:** **Yean Carlos Gil** and **Justin Jackson** combined on a seven hit shutout of the Hillcats last night in Lynchburg. The shutout win was Carolina's 12<sup>th</sup> of the season and brought them to 12-13 in shutout games this year... The Mudcats scored the only run of last night's game and did so without recording a RBI. **Connor Lien** scored from third on a double steal in the first last night and the Mudcats held on for a 1-0 win. It was the only win this season for Carolina when failing to record a RBI in a game... The Mudcats improved to 51-22 when scoring first last night. Their 51 wins when scoring first are the most in the league this season.

**ON TO THE NEXT ONE:** Carolina continues its final road trip and final series of the season tonight with game two of four in Lynchburg. The Mudcats won the series opener 1-0 last night at Calvin Falwell Field and tonight turn to starter **Matt Bywater** in hopes of winning their third straight and taking a 2-0 series lead against the Hillcats. Bywater last pitched on 8/30 at Five County Stadium against the Hillcats and allowed three runs and 11 hits over just three innings pitched. Bywater is 2-1 with a 2.61 ERA over four starts since joining the Mudcats last month.

**TRENDING:** **Connor Lien** has hit safely in six straight and is also batting .314/.368/.490 (16-for-51, 10r, 2hr, 8rbi) over his last 13 games... **Joey Meneses** is currently 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in average over the last seven days (.421/.526/.421, 8-for-19, 1r, 3rbi)... **Keith Curcio** is currently 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in average over the last seven days (.389/.500/.400, 7-for-18, 3r, 4rbi)... **Justin Jackson** has three saves and a 0.00 ERA over his last seven games and 11.2 innings.

**YEAR-END ALL-STARS:** The Carolina League recognized **Johan Camargo**, **Connor Lien** and **Jacob Schrader** as year-end All-Stars on 8/29. **Camargo** was recognized as the league's top shortstop, **Lien** was listed as one of four All-Star outfielders and **Schrader** earned designated hitter of the year honors.

**FIRST IMPRESSION:** **Connor Lien** has led off a game 18 times in the second half and the Mudcats are 13-5 with him as their leadoff man in the lineup. Lien is batting .300/.375/.543 (21-for-70, 2r, 3 2b, 1 3b, 4hr, 11rbi, 6bb, 21so) as the leadoff man in the second half... **Keith Curcio** is batting .214/.264/.321 (42-for-196, 21r, 5 2b, 5 3b, 2hr, 15rbi, 13bb, 37so) as Carolina's primary leadoff man in the second half. The Mudcats are 23-25 with Curcio as their leadoff batter in the second half. Curcio is also batting .337/.409/.455 overall this season when batting second.

**#WINNING:** The Mudcats are currently tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> in most wins in the league at 70-66 overall this season. Those 70 wins are the club's most during its Carolina League era. They were 62-74 in 2014, 57-83 in 2013 and 63-77 in 2012.

**WHERE THEY RANK:** **Connor Lien** is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in batting average (.286), tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> in stolen bases (33), tied for 4<sup>th</sup> in hits (126) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in most strikeouts (125)... **Carlos Franco** is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in most games played (131), 5<sup>th</sup> in extra-base hits (43) and 4<sup>th</sup> in most base on balls (62). Franco is also tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in extra-base (33) hits since June 1... **Seth Webster** is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in earned run average (2.91), is 2<sup>nd</sup> in WHIP (1.09), 1<sup>st</sup> in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.52) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in fewest base runners (10.14)... **Blair Walters** is 4<sup>th</sup> in the league in ERA (3.00) & 3<sup>rd</sup> in avg. against (.244).

**ROSTER UPDATE:** The Braves transferred **RHP Brandon Barker** and **RHP Andrew Waszak** back to the Mudcats from Triple-A Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi on 9/3. The Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> transactions were the 93<sup>rd</sup> and 94<sup>th</sup> of the season for the Mudcats. Carolina had only eight roster transactions before the bus accident on 5/12 (86 since).

### FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH:

- 2015 Mudcats reliever **Matt Marksberry** made his MLB debut on 7/31 in PHI (1.2ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 0so, 2ir-2irs).
- The Mudcats are 36-31 and are batting .242 with an average of 3.82 runs/game and a 3.25 ERA in the Second Half.
- The Mudcats are 51-42 since snapping their 12 game losing streak on May 29 (.249 avg, 4.04 runs/game, 3.26 ERA).
- The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 while a member of the Southern League (Double-A, Florida Marlins).
- **Seth Webster** leads Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio (12.86) among qualified pitchers.
- **Connor Lien** leads the league in most outfield assists (19) and double plays (6).

### MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

**BRICENO:** Was 2-for-4 on 6/28 and brought his avg. up to .200 or above (.203) for the first time since 4/15 (.200).

**CURCIO:** Hit .542/.656/.792 (6r, 3 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) between 6/8 and 6/14 and was named Player of the Week.

**CAMARGO:** First home run of the season was a 2-run shot to right on 8/16 in Frederick.

**FRANCO:** Led the Carolina League with 14 extra base hits in June (14 xbh, 8 2b, 2 3b, 4hr).

**GEBHARDT:** Was signed as a minor league free agent by the Braves on 8/20. Began year in Arizona system.

**GIARDINA:** Had back-to-back multi hit games on 5/30 (2-for-4, R) and 5/31 (2-for-4, RBI) versus Wilmington.

**HARPER:** Was 1-for-2 w/2 RBI on 7/2 vs. WS. Also made bare hand catch that was SportsCenter's Top 10 No. 1 play.

**KRIETEMEIER:** Hit safely in 5 straight games between 7/24-8/15 and had go-ahead 2-run 2B in 10<sup>th</sup> in Wilmington.

**LIEN:** Hit .375/.429/.667 from 7/6-7/12 (9-for-24, 3r, 2hr, 6rbi, 5sb, 1.095 OPS) and was named Player of the Week.

**MENESES:** Snapped a season high 12 game hitting streak after going 0-for-1 as a PH on 8/22 in Winston-Salem.

**ODOM:** Hit first professional grand slam on 6/9 vs. Potomac. The GS gave Carolina a 13-10 lead in the 8<sup>th</sup>.

**PETERSON:** Went 4-for-4 for the second time in a game this season on 8/24 vs. Wilmington at FCS.

**TL;DR:**

- Signed as a free agent on 8/13/15 by the Braves
- Began the 2015 season with the Southern Illinois Miners in the Frontier League and was 8-4 with a 2.36 ERA over 16 starts.
- Threw the first (nine inning) no-hitter in Southern Illinois Miners history on 6/12/15 (9ip, 0h, 0r, 2bb, 10so) vs. the Evansville Otters.
- Was named the Frontier League pitcher of the year following the 2014 season (8-4, 2.37 ERA, 21g, 20gs, 129.1ip, 86h, 46r, 34er, 60bb, 114so)
- Originally drafted by the Orioles in the 7th round of the 2010 draft out of Pepperdine.
- Spent the majority of the 2012 season with the Frederick Keys and was 1-2 with a 5.67 ERA over 19 games and five starts.
- Was 3-7 with a 3.63 ERA over 44 games and 19 starts in the Orioles system between 2011 and 2012.

**LAST START:** Bywater last started on 8/30 vs. Lynchburg and worked through a season low three innings pitched. He gave up a run in each of the first three innings before leaving with the game tied 3-3. He allowed 11 hits, gave up three runs and struck out two while throwing 55 pitches (39 strikes) in the start.

**2015:** The Braves signed LHP Matt Bywater on 8/13/15 and assigned him to Carolina after RHP Andrew Thurman was promoted to Double-A Mississippi. **8/14:** Allowed three unearned runs and suffered a tough luck loss in his Mudcats debut in Frederick. He walked five, struck out eight and allowed five hits over five innings pitched. All three runs scored in the third and followed a two-out fielding error by Carlos Franco. The Mudcats lost the game 3-2 after also scoring two runs in the third. **8/20:** Hurled seven scoreless frames with seven strikeouts in his home debut against the Salem Red Sox. He walked one and gave up just three hits while earning his first victory with the Mudcats. It was also his first victory in affiliated minor league baseball since he earned a victory in the Baltimore Orioles farm system with Double-A Bowie on September 3, 2012. **8/25:** Started against the Blue Rocks and led the Mudcats to a 7-4 home while earning his second straight victory. He held the Blue Rocks scoreless through the fourth before allowing two runs in the fifth. In all he allowed three earned runs and nine hits over five and 2/3 innings and finished with his second straight home win. Bywater finished the start with a walk, three strikeouts and 99 pitches (71 strikes) over his near six inning start.

Bywater was most recently with the Southern Illinois Miners of the Independent Frontier League and was 8-4 with a 2.36 ERA over 16 starts before joining the Braves system. He entered the 2015 season with Southern Illinois as the reigning Frontier League pitcher of the year after posting a 2.36 ERA over 21 starts and 20 games with Southern Illinois in 2014. Bywater threw the first no-hitter in Southern Illinois Miners history on 6/12/15 against the Evansville Otters. Bywater walked a batter in the fifth, walked one in the ninth and struck out 10 in the no-hit performance.

Bywater was originally drafted by the Orioles in the 7th round of the 2010 draft out of Pepperdine. He made his debut with the GCL Orioles in 2011 and posted a 0.59 ERA over six games and four starts before moving to Delmarva later that same year. He finished his affiliated baseball career in Bowie in 2012 after making just one appearance in September of that season with the Baysox. He spent the majority of the 2012 season with the Frederick Keys and was 1-2 with a 5.67 ERA over 19 games and five starts.

The Thousand Oaks, CA native was 3-7 with a 3.63 ERA over 44 games and 19 starts in the Orioles system between 2011 and 2012.

**MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES**

**BARKER:** Made spot start for Triple-A Gwinnett on 7/5 vs. Charlotte (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). Left with two men on (both later scored) in the fifth.  
**BROSIUS:** Placed on the disabled list on 5/14. Last pitched on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (6.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 1bb, 4so).  
**BYWATER:** Struck out seven over seven scoreless frames while earning his first win on 8/20 vs. Salem at Five County Stadium.  
**FURNEY:** Struck out a season high seven batters over seven innings on 5/22 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 8h, 3r, 2er, 2bb, 7so).  
**GIL:** Tossed a seven inning one-hit shutout (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 6so) while earning his second straight victory since returning from Rome on 8/24 vs Wilmington.  
**JANAS:** Placed on disabled list on 5/8. Led the league in ERA (0.56), WHIP (0.53) and lowest average against (.140) before going on DL.  
**PARSONS:** Earned a victory in his first start with Carolina on 7/21 vs. Wilmington (5ip, 8h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 0so).

**WALTERS:** Pitched through the seventh for the first time on 7/1 and earned his third win of the season as a starter.  
**WASZAK:** Took a no-hitter into the seventh on 7/2 vs. Winston-Salem at Five County Stadium (W, 6.2ip, 1h, 1r, 0er, 2bb, 6so).  
**WEBSTER:** Led Carolina League in earned run average from 8/16 through 8/21 (2.52 ERA).

Luis Salazar is entering his fifth season with the Atlanta Braves and his first as the manager of the Carolina Mudcats. The 2015 season marks Salazar's 13th year as a minor league manager. Salazar guided Atlanta's previous Class A Advanced club, the Lynchburg Hillcats, to the playoffs in three of the last four years. **#43 - Derrick Lewis, Pitching Coach**

The 2015 season marks the third for Derrick Lewis as the pitching coach of Atlanta's Class A Advanced affiliate and his 13th overall in the Braves system. Lewis has been the pitching coach of the Lynchburg Hillcats (2011-2014), Rome Braves (2008-2010) Danville Braves (2004-2007) and the Gulf Coast League Braves (2004-2007). Carlos Mendez enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Carolina Mudcats, his second with the Braves Class A Advanced club and his ninth season overall in the Braves organization.
