ICYMI: Lynchburg's Dorsy Paulino was 3-for-4 with two runs and Joe Sever drove in two while going 2-for-4 and the Hillcats escaped with a 5-4 win against the Mudcats on Sunday afternoon at Calvin Falwell Field. **Reed Harper** was 2-for-3 with two RBI in the loss for Carolina. The Mudcats led only once in Sunday's loss in Lynchburg. They fell behind after the Hillcats rallied for an early run off starter **Blair Walters** in the second, but later took the lead in the third. Lynchburg jumped ahead again in the fourth, but the Mudcats tied it up in the sixth before the Hillcats scored the go-ahead and final run in the seventh.

ABOUT THE LAST ONE: The Mudcats were held without an extra-base hit for the second straight game for just the second time this season yesterday. The last time they were held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back games came over the final two games of the first half on June 20 (L, 4-0) and June 21 (L, 1-0) in Potomac. They have not been held without an extra-base hit in three straight games this season.

ON TO THE NEXT ONE: **Seth Webster** will get the start in today's series and season finale in Lynchburg at Calvin Falwell Field. Webster is 8-7 with the league's 3rd lowest earned run average (2.91) this season and was named by the Atlanta Braves as the Mudcats' pitcher of the month for August yesterday. The side-arm throwing right-hander was 2-1 and posted a 2.31 ERA over five starts last month. He currently leads Minor League Baseball with a 12.86 K/BB ratio (90K/7BB) and leads the Carolina League in innings pitched (123.2) since May 23.

TRENDING: **Johan Camargo** is 6-for-14 with four runs, five walks and one strikeout over his last five games... **Carlos Franco** is batting .438/.571/.750 with two doubles, a home run and six RBI over his last five games... **Dustin Peterson** is 0-for-16 over his last four games... **Justin Jackson** has three saves and a 0.00 ERA over his last seven games and 11.2 innings.

YEAR-END ALL-STARS: The Carolina League recognized **Johan Camargo**, **Connor Lien** and **Jacob Schrader** as year-end All-Stars on 8/29. **Camargo** was recognized as the league's top shortstop, **Lien** was listed as one of four All-Star outfielders and **Schrader** earned designated hitter of the year honors.

FIRST IMPRESSION: **Connor Lien** has led off a game 20 times in the second half and the Mudcats are 13-7 when Lien leads off. Lien is batting .282/.367/.500 (22-for-78, 24r, 3 2b, 1 3b, 4hr, 11rbi, 8bb, 24so) as the leadoff man in the second half. Lien is batting .253/.327/.432 (24-for-95) overall as Carolina's leadoff man this season. He was hitting .118/.118/.118 (2-for-17, 6so) when batting first on July 4.

#WINNING: The Mudcats are currently 4th in the league in most wins at 70-68 overall this season. Those 70 wins are the club's most during its Carolina League era. They were 62-74 in 2014, 57-83 in 2013 and 63-77 in 2012.

WHERE THEY RANK: **Connor Lien** is 3rd in the league in batting average (.283), tied for 2nd in stolen bases (34), 5th in hits (127) and 2nd in the league in most strikeouts (128)... **Carlos Franco** is 2nd in the league in most games played (133), 5th in extra-base hits (43) and 4th in most base on balls (65). Franco is also tied for 2nd in the league in extra-base (33) hits since June 1... **Seth Webster** is 3rd in the league in earned run average (2.91), is 2nd in WHIP (1.09), 1st in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.52) and 2nd in fewest base runners (10.14)... **Blair Walters** is 5th in the league in ERA (3.13) & 3rd in avg. against (.249).

ROSTER UPDATE: The Braves transferred **RHP Brandon Barker** and **RHP Andrew Waszak** back to the Mudcats from Triple-A Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi on 9/3. The Sept. 3rd transactions were the 93rd and 94th of the season for the Mudcats. Carolina had only eight roster transactions before the bus accident on 5/12 (86 since).

FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH:

- 2015 Mudcats reliever **Matt Marksberry** made his MLB debut on 7/31 in PHI (1.2ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 0so, 2ir-2irs).
- The Mudcats are 36-33 and are batting .242 with an average of 3.83 runs/game and a 3.35 ERA in the Second Half.
- The Mudcats are 51-44 since snapping their 12 game losing streak on May 29 (.249 avg, 4.01 runs/game, 3.34 ERA).
- The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 while a member of the Southern League (Double-A, Florida Marlins).
- **Seth Webster** leads Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio (12.86) among qualified pitchers.
- **Connor Lien** leads the league in most outfield assists (20) and double plays (7).

MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

- BRICENO:** Was 2-for-4 on 6/28 and brought his avg. up to .200 or above (.203) for the first time since 4/15 (.200).
- CURCIO:** Hit .542/.656/.792 (6r, 3 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) between 6/8 and 6/14 and was named Player of the Week.
- CAMARGO:** First home run of the season was a 2-run shot to right on 8/16 in Frederick.
- FRANCO:** Led the Carolina League with 14 extra base hits in June (14 xbh, 8 2b, 2 3b, 4hr).
- GEBHARDT:** Was signed as a minor league free agent by the Braves on 8/20. Began year in Arizona system.
- GIARDINA:** Had back-to-back multi hit games on 5/30 (2-for-4, R) and 5/31 (2-for-4, RBI) versus Wilmington.
- HARPER:** Was 1-for-2 w/2 RBI on 7/2 vs. WS. Also made bare hand catch that was SportsCenter's Top 10 No. 1 play.
- KRIEMEIER:** Hit safely in 5 straight games between 7/24-8/15 and had go-ahead 2-run 2B in 10th in Wilmington.
- LIEN:** Hit .375/.429/.667 from 7/6-7/12 (9-for-24, 3r, 2hr, 6rbi, 5sb, 1.095 OPS) and was named Player of the Week.
- MENESES:** Snapped a season high 12 game hitting streak after going 0-for-1 as a PH on 8/22 in Winston-Salem.
- ODOM:** Hit first professional grand slam on 6/9 vs. Potomac. The grand slam gave Carolina a 13-10 lead in the 8th.
- PETERSON:** Was named the Mudcats' batter of the month in August by the Braves (.272/.327/.369, 28h, 4 2b, 2hr, 16rbi)

TL;DR:

- Is currently 3rd in the Carolina League in earned run average (2.91), is 2nd in WHIP (1.09) and lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.52).
- Owns Minor League Baseball's best K/BB ratio (12.86) among qualified pitchers.
- Leads the Carolina League in most innings pitched since making his debut on May 23 (120.2 innings).
- Webster's 1.4 BB% and 12.86 K/BB ratio is the best in the Carolina League this season.
- Pitched 45.1 consecutive innings without issuing a walk between starts on 6/11 and 7/25.
- Led Mudcats to losing streak (12 straight) snapping victory on 5/29 against Myrtle Beach (W, 7.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 2bb, 6so)
- Was named by the Atlanta Braves as the Mudcats' pitcher of the month for August after going 2-1 with a 2.31 ERA (5gs, 35ip, 9er, 3bb, 29so).
- Became first Mudcats pitcher to pitch through the eighth on 7/3 vs. Winston-Salem (8.0ip, 7h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 5so).
- Was 14-6 with a 2.88 ERA over 31 games and 200.0 innings with the Schaumburg Boomers between 2013 and 2015.
- Was 3-0 with a 0.78 ERA over three post-season starts for the Frontier League champion Schaumburg Boomers in 2014 (23ip, 5h, 20so).
- Tossed a CG shutout with 13 strikeouts and just two hits allowed in a wild card playoff game against Lake Erie last season.
- Clinched the Boomers' second straight Frontier League title with a seven inning effort against River City last season (7.0ip, 1r).
- Before signing with Atlanta, Webster was the Schaumburg franchise career leader in starts, innings, complete games, wins and strikeouts.
- Finished the 2014 season sixth in the Frontier League in innings pitched with 118.0.
- Was named the American Southwest Conference East Division Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 1.77 ERA (91.2ip, 65so) with DIII Louisiana College.
- Led the American Southwest Conference in wins (10), complete games (11) and shutouts (4) while with the Louisiana College Wildcats.

LAST START: Webster last started on 9/2 in Frederick and finished his start with five runs (four earned) allowed over six innings pitched. Webster also gave up nine hits and struck out five in the no decision.

2015: 5/29: Webster shutout the visiting Pelicans over seven full innings while leading the Mudcats to a 12 game losing streak snapping 2-0 victory at Five County Stadium on May 29. He struck out six, walked two and held Myrtle Beach to four hits over seven scoreless while earning his first victory of the season... **7/3:** Allowed just two runs over a season high eight innings pitched and struck out five. Webster allowed a run in the second and one in the sixth and gave up seven hits in the loss. **7/8:** Struck out a season high eight batters while allowing just two runs over six and 2/3 innings pitched. **7/25:** Kept the Pelicans without a run over seven full innings pitched while throwing 91 pitches with 58 for strikes. He walked one, struck out one and scattered four hits in the victory. **7/30:** Finished with just two runs allowed and seven strikeouts over six and 2/3 innings pitched while earning his second straight victory. **8/5:** Won his third straight start after allowing just one run over seven innings pitched against Winston-Salem. Scattered five hits, struck out seven and picked up his 10th quality start of the year. **8/16:** Allowed just one unearned run over seven innings pitched while picking up a win in Frederick against the Keys. He struck out eight, did not issue a walk and gave up six hits while lowering his then league best earned run average to 2.52 ERA on the season. **8/22:** Took the loss after allowing a season high six earned runs over seven innings pitched in Winston-Salem. All six runs were allowed in the game changing fourth that featured four doubles and five hits overall. All five were allowed to batters hitting from the left side and were allowed by Webster. **8/27:** Allowed just one run over seven innings pitched against Lynchburg in his final home start of the season. He lost a 1-0 lead in the seventh, but the Mudcats later took the lead in the same frame. Carolina later lost the game 8-2 after allowing seven runs in the ninth. Webster finished the start with seven strikeouts and eight hits allowed.

Webster was signed by the Braves a non-drafted free agent earlier this year from the Frontier League's Schaumburg Boomers. He made his Atlanta organizational debut with the Rome Braves on 5/18 against Charleston and allowed six earned runs on seven hits over five innings pitched. He walked two and struck out seven in his affiliated ball debut, and suffered the loss in a 6-2 loss to the RiverDogs. Webster was 14-6 with a 2.88 ERA over three seasons (31g, 200.0ip, 185h, 77r, 64er, 38bb, 145so) with the Boomers before signing with the Braves.

BARKER: Made spot start for Triple-A Gwinnett on 7/5 vs. Charlotte (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). Left with two men on (both later scored) in the fifth.
BROSIUS: Placed on the disabled list on 5/14. Last pitched on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (6.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 1bb, 4so).
BYWATER: Struck out seven over seven scoreless frames while earning his first win on 8/20 vs. Salem at Five County Stadium.
FURNEY: Struck out a season high seven batters over seven innings on 5/22 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 8h, 3r, 2er, 2bb, 7so).
GIL: Tossed a seven inning one-hit shutout (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 6so) while earning his second straight victory since returning from Rome on 8/24 vs Wilmington.
JANAS: Placed on disabled list on 5/8. Led the league in ERA (0.56), WHIP (0.53) and lowest average against (.140) before going on DL.

#4 - Luis Salazar, Manager

Luis Salazar is entering his fifth season with the Atlanta Braves and his first as the manager of the Carolina Mudcats. The 2015 season marks Salazar's 13th year as a minor league manager. Salazar guided Atlanta's previous Class A Advanced club, the Lynchburg Hillcats, to the playoffs in three of the last four years. His 2012 Hillcats club finished 72-68 and won the Carolina League title versus Winston Salem. Salazar first joined the Braves organization in 2011 after spending three years as the hitting coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers Double A affiliate. He has over 15 years of coaching experience and in his career has compiled a 567-623 career record. Salazar has also managed the Vero Beach Dodgers (Class A, 2006), the Gulf Coast League Dodgers (Rookie, 2002-2005) and the Beloit Snappers (Class A, 1996-1997). Additionally, Salazar has been the hitting coach for Triple A Louisville (1998-1999) and Triple A Indianapolis (2000). Salazar played in 13 major league seasons and for four different teams. He played for the San Diego Padres (1980-1984, 1987, 1989), the Chicago White Sox (1985-1986), the Detroit Tigers (1988) and the Chicago Cubs (1989-1992). Salazar hit .261 with 1,070 hits over his 13 year MLB playing career.

The 2015 season marks the third for Derrick Lewis as the pitching coach of Atlanta's Class A Advanced affiliate and his 13th overall in the Braves system. #35 - Carlos Mendez, Hitting Coach

Carlos Mendez enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Carolina Mudcats, his second with the Braves Class A Advanced club and his ninth season overall in the Braves organization. Mendez originally began last season with rookie level Danville, but was later assigned to Lynchburg in mid-April. Mendez joined the Braves organization in 2008 as the hitting instructor for Danville and remained with the rookie level Braves through 2010. He then took over as the hitting coach in Rome from 2011 to 2012. In 2013, Mendez served as the hitting coach of the Gulf Coast League Braves before returning to Danville in 2014. Mendez's playing career lasted from 1991 through 2007. Over those 16 seasons, Mendez would play for five different organizations including Kansas City, Detroit, Oakland, Baltimore and Atlanta. He was a career .296 hitter in the minors and a perennial all-star. Mendez reached the big leagues in 2003 with the Baltimore Orioles. He played in 26 games for the O's over four months and hit .222 with 10 hits and two doubles. He was originally signed by Kansas City as a non-drafted free agent in 1991.
